Item No. 2 Review of monitoring of Water Quality of River Sutlej & Beas

- Punjab Pollution Control Board monitors the quality of Water in river Beas and Sutlej. A copy of the status of quality of water Quality of River Sutlej and Beas for the month of Jan. 2019 is attached at Annexure-1. Chief Engineer (Water), Punjab Pollution Control Board to present the status of Water Quality in the rivers.
- PPCB is in the process of installing continuous monitoring stations for water quality of river Beas and Sutlej. A copy of the same is enclosed as Annexure The Status of installation of continuous monitoring systems for water quality in River Sutlej and Beas will be presented by Chief Engineer (Water),

PPCB.

- 3. PPCB also needs to finalize a sound protocol/ standard operating procedure for taking samples of water quality and explain the quality of water at various locations with reasons.
- 4. The committee may kindly take note of the Status of the quality of the water.

Item No. 3 Review of monitoring of functioning of existing STPs in the catchment area

- There are 16 and 51 STPs operational in the catchment areas of River Beas and Sutlej. Punjab Pollution Control Board monitors the functioning of STPs in the catchment area of rive Beas and Sutlej. The results for the month of Jan. 2019 are enclosed at Annexure-3. Chief Engineer (Water), PPCB will present the status of functioning of the existing STPS.
- 2. One of the key reasons for non-functioning of STPs has been lack of timely availability of funds for Operation and maintenance of STPs. The status of requirement of funds and funds released so far in respect of various STPs is given in the **Annexure-4**. Administrative Secretary, Department of Local Government will present the status of availability of funds for O&M of STPs.
- 3. PWSSB monitors the characteristics of sludge in the operational STPs. A copy of the Status is enclosed at **Annexure-5**. PWSSB to present the same in the meeting.
- 4. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No. 4 Review of monitoring of functioning of CETPs in the catchment area

- 1. Punjab Pollution Control Board monitors the functioning of CETPs in the State. The current status of functioning of existing CETPs in the State for the month of Jan 2019 is given in **Annexure-6**. Chief Engineer (Water), PPCB will present the same.
- 2. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No. 5 Review of monitoring of functioning of ETPs installed by industries

1. Punjab Pollution Control Board monitors the functioning of ETPs installed by Industries by way of regular inspections. The status report in respect of inspections carried out by PPCB, results of the same and action taken by PPCB are given in **Annexure-7**. Chief Engineer (Water), PPCB will present the current status in the meeting.

2. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No. 6 Review of progress of Setting up of New / Up-gradation/ Rehabilitation of STPs

- There are still many towns in the catchment area of River Beas and Sutlej discharging untreated water in river Sutlej due to lack of STPs in these towns. Some of the STPs require up-gradation and rehabilitation. The current status of setting up of new/ up-gradation/ rehabilitation of STPs is given in Annexure-8.
- 2. Administrative Secretary, Local Government will present the current status.
- 3. The Committee may kindly review the same.

Item No. 7 Review of Progress of Setting up of new/ upgrading of CETPs in catchment area

- Punjab Pollution Control Board is currently facilitating and coordinating setting up/ upgrading of various CETPs in the State. The current status of setting up of various CETPs is given in Annexure-9. Chief Engineer (Water) will present the current status and challenges in setting up of CETPs in the State.
- 2. Punjab Pollution Control Board is also monitoring the Up-gradation of 14 ETPs by large scale dyeing units to achieve the standards at par with CETPs. The current status will be updated by the Board.
- 3. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No. 8 Review of Progress of Setting up of ETPs for dairy and other misc. waste

- 2. Municipal Corporations in the State are setting up following ETPs:
 - (i). 2 ETPs of 5 MLD & 10 MLD capacity for dairy effluents by MC, Ludhiana
 - (ii). ETP for waste water of slaughter house by MC, Ludhiana
 - (iii). Biogas plant & Carcass handling plant by MC, Ludhiana
 - (iv). ETP of 5 MLD capacity for dairy effluents by MC, Jalandhar
 - (v). Biogas plant by MC, Jalandhar
- 3. The current status is given at Annexure-10. MC Ludhiana and MC Jalandhar

will present the current status.

4. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No. 9 Reconciliation of Waste Water & Industrial Effluents for city of Ludhiana

- Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana has been raising the issue of quantity of waste water discharged into Budha Nalla being far excess of domestic supply of waste water. PPCB has also made some projections in this regard. However, there is substantial difference between the waste water discharged estimated by MC, Ludhian and PPCB.
- 2. The matter needs to be discussed.

Item No. 10 Review of progress of release of Fresh Water in Budha Nallah & Holy Bein

- 1. In order to enhance the assimilative capacity of Budha Nallah and Holy Bein, it has been proposed in the action plan to:
 - (i). Release of 200 cusec of water from Sirhind Canal to Budha Nallah
 - (ii). Release of 350 cusec of water from Mukerian Hydel Channel to Bein
- 2. The Department of Water Resources will submit the current status of progress as per **Annexure-11**.
- 3. The Committee may kindly review the current Status.

Item No. 11 Review of Re-use of Treated Waste Water for Irrigation and other purposes

- 1. Department of Soil & Water Conservation will present the plan for utilization of treated waste water for irrigation purpose and Department of local government for construction and other urban usage.
- 2. Department of Water Resources will present the plan for utilization of waste water for irrigation where more than 50 MLD is being treated.
- 3. Department of Water Resources to submit the progress w.r.t. Action Plan for revival of Lower Budha Nallah to use the treated waste water of Ludhiana city for irrigation.
- 4. The current status as intimated DSWC is at Annexure-12.
- 5. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No.12 Review of action taken to prevent dumping of Solid Wasteinto Budha Nallah

- 1. NGT has ordered that suitable measures need to be taken to prevent dumping of solid waste in various water channels including fixing of wire mesh etc.
- 2. Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to present the current status.

Item No.13 Review of Progress for Setting up of Treatment Facilities in Village

- 1. There are number of villages in the catchment area of these rivers discharging their waste water directly and indirectly into rivers:
 - (i). 336 villages falling in catchment area of river Sutlej
 - (ii). 75 villages falling in the catchment area of river Beas
- 2. Department of Finance has allocated budget of Rs.50 Crores to Department of Rural Development and Panchayat(DRDP) for setting up of treatment facilities. Accordingly, the Department has prioritized the villages to covered in Phase 1.
- 3. The current status of the progress is given in **Annexure-13.** Administrative Secretary, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat will present the current status.
- 4. The Committee may kindly review the current Status.

Item No.14 Review of Shifting of Small / Medium scale scattered dyeing units

- 1. Department of Industries and Commerce will present the status of action taken on the following:
 - (i). Timeline for shifting of units located in non-designated areas to the designated industrial area for their connection to the up-coming CETPs
 - (ii). Timeline for shifting of units located in designated areas which are not feasible to connect with proposed CETPs to the designated industrial areas having feasibility to connect with up-coming CETPs.
- 2. The committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No.15 Review of Progress of installation of OCMS & CCTVs for STPs & Industries

- The Action plan has stipulated installation of Online Continuous Monitoring System and CCTVs for STPs. The same are to be installed by PWSSB / MCL/MCJ/DWSS and other agencies responsible for operation and maintenance of these STPs.PPCB is responsible for OCMS and CCTVs for industries.
- 2. The Current status is given in **Annexure-12** and **Annexure-13** and the same will be presented by Department of Local Government and Punjab Pollution Control Board in the meeting.
- 3. The Committee may kindly review the current status.

Item No.16 Review of the progress regarding organization of Health Check-up Camps

- 1. The Department of Health & Family Welfare has been tasked with organization of health check up camps in the catchment areas of rivers. The current status of organization of health check-ups is given in **Annexure-14**.

- 3. The Committee may kindly review the current status.
