**Item No. 2 Confirmation of the minutes of the 2nd meeting**

The minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Committee have been circulated to all concerned vide letter no. DECC/2019/116-124 dated 20.03.2019. No comments have been received from any quarters. The minutes may accordingly be confirmed.

**Item No. 3 Action taken report on the minutes of 2nd Meeting**

Key Actions to be taken up by the departments in pursuance to 2<sup>nd</sup> SLC meeting are enlisted as under:

- (i) Department of Local Government
  - (a). Frame model bye-laws for management of solid waste, C & D waste and plastic waste by incorporating the provisions of respective Rules; levying of spot fine and delegation of powers to officers and all other relevant areas.
  - (b). Nominate Nodal Officer from the department
- (ii) Punjab Pollution Control Board
  - (a). Nominate Nodal Officer from the Board.
  - (b). Issue suitable instructions to State Electoral Officer to avoid single-use plastic
  - (c). Extend technical support involving Punjab State Council for Science & Technology for appropriate measures/ technologies for waste management.

- (iii) Department of Environment
  - (a). Notification of SLC and DLTFs as per the directions of NGT and inclusion of Mr. Babu Ram, Ex-member secretary, PPCB in the Executive Committee.
  - (b). Nominate Nodal Officer from the department
  - (c). Issuance of appropriate orders to ban use of single use plastic items in the premises of Govt. offices.
- (iv) Department of Health & Family Welfare
  - (a). Brought matter of exemption for installation of ETPs to the Govt. HCFs < 30 beds capacity to the notice of the State Advisory Body to further take up the issue with CPCB/ Central Govt.
  - (b). Ensure regular meetings of State and district level committees constituted under BMW Rules, 2016

**Item No. 4 To take note of the orders of Hon'ble NGT dated 07.03.2019**

The matter pertaining to O.A no 606 of 2018 was enlisted on 07.03.2019 before Hon'ble NGT, wherein Chief Secretary presented the status of compliance of the orders dated 16.01.2019. The Hon'ble NGT has taken serious view for lapses in the steps taken for implementation of rules and for ensuring sustainable development. The Hon'ble NGT has issued certain directions, which are reproduced as under:

- (i) Steps for compliance of Rules 22 and 24 of SWM Rules be now taken within six weeks to the extent. Similar steps be taken with regard to Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules and Plastic Waste Management Rules.
- (ii) At least three major cities and three major towns in the State and at least three Panchayats in every District may be notified on the website within two weeks from today as model cities/towns/villages which will be made fully compliant within next six months.
- (iii) The remaining cities, towns and Village Panchayats of the State may be made fully compliant in respect of environmental norms within one year.
- (iv) A quarterly report be furnished by the Chief Secretary, every three months. First such report shall be furnished by 30th June, 2019.

- (v) The Chief Secretary may personally monitor the progress, at least once in a month, with all the District Magistrates.
- (vi) The District Magistrates or other Officers may be imparted requisite training.
- (vii) The District Magistrates may monitor the status of compliance of environmental norms, at least once in two weeks.
- (viii) Performance audit of functioning of all regulatory bodies may be got conducted and remedial measures be taken, within six months.
- (ix) The Chief Secretary may remain present in person before the Tribunal on 16.09.2019 with the status of compliance of orders.
