No. 10/167/2013-STE(5)/1510178/1 .-In pursuance of Notification No. 10/182/2017-STE(5)/1404038/1 dated 25.01.2019 issued by the Govt. of Punjab, Department of Science, Technology & Environment, wherein, Directorate of Environment & Climate Change, Punjab has been assigned the work for providing secretarial support/services to the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) & State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) for disposal of cases of environmental clearance and any issue pertaining to above authorities.

2. In order to provide requisite logistics, secretariat, IT and other technical support to SEIAA/SEAC, following fee shall be paid by the applicants seeking environment clearances:

Nature of the project	Building and Construction Projects	Area Development projects	Mining projects	Industrial Projects
Proposed Fee	Rs.2 per sqm	Rs.3000 per ha OR Rs.1 per sqm (in case of built up area)	Rs.2,000 per ha	Rs.10,000 per crore of Total project cost*

**Total Project Cost includes the cost of Land, Building, Infrastructure and Plant & Machinery.*

3. The processing fee shall be paid by the applicants in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favor of Executive Director, Punjab State Council for Science & Technology, payable at Chandigarh and the demand draft shall be submitted along with the application. No application will be received/entertained without the requisite processing fee.

4. The processing fee shall be applicable to all cases for which clearance is required from SEIAA/SEAC namely:-

- (i) All new projects, expansion & modernization of existing projects, any change in the product mix in an existing unit or any other project/activities for which clearance is required from SEIAA/SEAC under EIA notifications issued from time to time.

- (ii) 25% of the total fees will be taken during submission of Terms of Reference application and balance fees @ 75% of the total fees will be taken at the time of Environmental clearance application.
- (iii) No refund of processing fees shall be entertained once the application is submitted.
