## Subject: Minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 29.5.2019 at 11:30 p.m. in the Committee Hall, Mini Secretariat Roopnagar under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar to review the action points of the draft action plan for control air pollution of Nangal town with the Stakeholder departments.

At the outset, the Asst. Environmental Engineer, PPCB informed that as Nangal town has been declared as non attainment town as the ambient air quality is not conforming to the prescribed standards in respect of PM<sub>10</sub> and in regard to which 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting had already been held on 16.04.2019 under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar. Now, the 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting is being convened to review the progress/compliance of the decisions of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting and also the information regarding various activities as provided by different stakeholder departments.

In the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting RTA was instructed to check the working of Pollution Under Control centers & their machinery, such that no false PUC certificate be issued by the operators of the PUC centers. It was also decided that RTA will carry out checking of vehicles by holding Nakas to check as to whether the vehicles are having valid PUC certificate or not and they will also issue challans to the violators and the vehicles found emitting visible emissions. He will also intimate the policy of the State Govt. for phasing out the diesel driven auto rickshaws and encouraging the use of e-rickshaws / CNG based rickshaws and use of public transport, However, RTA did not attend the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting and The Chairperson directed that explanation be sought from the absentees.

Chairperson decided that surprise inspection be carried out and report be submitted fort nightly to District Administration and Punjab Pollution Control Board and to bring the compiled report in next meetings and also bring the policy of the State Govt. for phasing out the diesel driven auto rickshaws and encouraging the use of e-rickshaws / CNG based rickshaws and use of public transport.
