

**Subject: Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 01.08.2019 at 11:00 a.m. in the Committee Hall, Mini Secretariat Roopnagar under the Chairmanship of Additional Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar to review the action points of the draft action plan for control air pollution of Nangal town with the Stakeholder departments.**

At the outset, the Asst. Environmental Engineer, PPCB informed that as Nangal town has been declared as non attainment town as the ambient air quality is not conforming to the prescribed standards in respect of PM<sub>10</sub> and in regard to which 4<sup>th</sup> meeting had already been held on 02.07.2019 under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar. Now, the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting is being convened to review the progress/compliance of the decisions of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting and also the information regarding various activities as provided by different stakeholder departments.
