

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

#### Agenda No. 11.2 Compliance of NGT order dated 08.04.21 in O.A No. 681/2018

- i. NGT vide above order directed that at least 1 no. manual Air Quality Monitoring Station must be installed at every District Head Quarter within 3 Months by SPCBs using the funds available under consent mechanism/ environmental compensation.
- ii. Any delay in execution of Action Plan beyond 01.11.21 will render the concerned states liable to pay compensation at least @ Rs. 10 lacs per month with liberty to recover the amount from the erring officers. Further, such compensation must be credited to a separate account to be operated by the Chief Secretary and the amount will be spent for restoration of environment.
- iii. Police and Environment Departments who are interested with responsibility of control of noise pollution must execute Action Plan including procurement of equipment's (Noise Level Meters/ Noise Limiters). Concerned States/ Heads of Police Force must be held liable to pay compensation @ Rs. 10 lacs per Month as failure to enforce above action plan.
- iv. Need for compliance O.A No. 283/2020 regarding control of fugitive dust emissions from road cleaning by sprinkling of treated waste water of STP by all MCs/Local Bodies in all cities having "Poor" Air Quality Index.
- v. The Chief Secretaries may continue to monitor progress in execution of Action Plans at State Level with the assistance of monitoring cells in their offices and the AQMCs.
- vi. DECC vide letter dated 25.06.2021 circulated the copy of above NGT order to all the Stakeholder Departments & Deputy Commissioners of NACs for its compliance.

- (ii) PPCB reported that the information in the prescribed proforma has been prepared and sent to Local Government vide letter dated 18.06.2021 for scrutiny at its end. Once, the report is received back from Local Government it would be forwarded to CPCB & MoEF&CC.

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# Agenda No. 11.5: Performance Evaluation Framework of Million Plus Cities for FY 2020-21 under 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission (FC-XV) Grant to State Finance/Local Government Department for implementation of Air Quality Measures

- (i) Ministry of Finance (MoF), GoI vide sanction letter dated 02.11.20 released Rs. 26 crores for Ludhiana and Rs. 19 crores for Amritsar ULB through State Finance Department to Local Govt as 1<sup>st</sup> instalment for Air Quality Measures including capacity building of Local Bodies as well as meeting the additional needs of the State Pollution Control Boards to appropriately assist the Local Bodies in monitoring the Ambient Air Quality. Further, MoEF vide sanction letter dated 26.04.21 released Rs. 26 crores for Ludhiana and Rs. 19 crores for Amritsar ULB as 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment.
- (ii) Local Govt. informed that the proposals of Rs. 45 Crore (1<sup>st</sup> Installment) was prepared for Ludhiana & Amritsar and submitted to MoEF&CC before 31.03.2021 whereas, preparation of proposals against 2<sup>nd</sup> Installment are under process & will be completed by 31.08.2021.
- (iii) In addition, CPCB released 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of Rs. 12.48 Crore directly to PPCB under National Clean Air Program (NCAP) for FY (2020-21).
- (iv) PPCB informed that Rs. 10 Crores are the committed funds for purchase of CAAQMS whereas, Rs 1.05 crore each was released to MCL & MCJ for purchase of mechanical sweepers.
